Many of you have seen the sad stories this week in various media about the dogs who died after swimming in Lake Allatoona and in North Carolina – apparently as a result of ingesting lake water affected by what is being called a “harmful” or “toxic” algae bloom.

Here on the NGA Lakes, we have not had conditions to support algae blooms of this nature. Georgia Power has guidelines in place for monitoring and responding to reports of algae blooms on our 17 lakes statewide.
